## INSTRUCTIONS

In celebration of the amazing people in your life who encourage you to live authentically:

- Share a reel (9 x 16) on your Instagram feed of you singing this verse from Elton John's 'Your Song': "I hope you don't mind, I hope don't mind that I put down in words, how wonderful life is while you're in the world [name]," adding in the name of the person who has always supported you to be your most authentic self
- Tag a person in your caption who has supported you
- Use the hashtag: #SpeakUpSingOutGiveaway
- Make sure you are following us on Instagram: @ejaf and that your profile is set to 'public'
- The deadline for the #SpeakUpSingOutGiveaway is Tuesday 18 June at 8pm ET.



## FILMING GUIDANCE

Here are some tips to help you with filming your Instagram reel:

- >: Orientation: Vertical ONLY (not landscape/horizontal)
- Background: Find a light-colored backdrop so there is significant contrast between you and your background. Anything non-distracting is okay (avoid artwork, words, busy/dark patterns)
- Lighting: Opt for a bright room (though not directly in the sun), near the window on a cloudy day, or other ambient light. Avoid harsh lighting, e.g. a lamp right above your head or direct sunlight, as this creates a lot of shadows.
